RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is the objective of Fulton County to insure that public work projects awarded by Fulton County shall be completed by well-trained and skilled contractors; and,

WHEREAS, requiring successful bidders for these projects to have participated in appropriate apprentice and training programs will achieve this objective; and,

WHEREAS, Fulton County desires to further define the term "responsible bidder" with regard to projects regarding funds for public works construction projects over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fulton County Board that contractors awarded contracts for public work as defined by state statute and this Resolution should, as a prerequisite to such contract, provide proof of participation in apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training for all construction contracts in excess of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00); and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
